## 2025 Year 7 Visual Arts Scholarship

Cecil Andrews College identifies artistically talented upper primary students in the local community through the Visual Arts Program. We are keen to attract such students to the 2025 Visual Arts program to further develop their artistic skills and Cecil Andrews College's growing lower school classroom programs.

The Cecil Andrews College Visual Arts scholarship provides funding towards tuition, specialist workshops in After School Art Club, and support to participate in art exhibitions and competitions.

Applicants will need to meet the following criteria:

- The candidate should be a student enrolled to attend Cecil Andrews College.
- The candidate must show excellence in a particular discipline of sculpture, drawing and/or painting.
- The candidate shows a willingness to actively contribute to Arts events throughout the year, such as the art exhibition and STEAM Festival.
- The candidate displays the ability to adhere to and uphold the Colleges ethos.
- The candidate must show a minimum of 90% attendance to all lessons and comply with all College policies.

Application Process:

- Candidates are required to complete a Scholarship Application Form
- Candidates are required to complete a Cecil Andrews College Enrolment Form
- Candidates will attend an interview with a Visual Arts teacher and provide a portfolio of artworks to display their techniques and skills with various mediums and chosen artistic style.
- Applications are to be submitted by Friday 22 November 2024. No late applications will be accepted.
- The successful applicant will be notified by Monday 9 December 2024.

Pathways:

Students undertaking the Year 7 Visual Arts Program will have the opportunity to study further Art courses in Years 8, 9 and 10, which can lead to ATAR, General and Certificate Visual Art courses in Years 11 and 12.
